### ENERGY XCHANGE LINDA PROCE-SNEDDON

Eight years ago a friend gave me a book of anonymous Tantric meditation paintings that are used as focal points for meditation by spiritual practitioners in contemporary Rajasthan, India. These vibratory works resonated deeply with me and I wished to create such simple but powerful works.

An earlier series MindForms was loosely inspired by these paintings. This Energy Xchange series is an evolution from the prior but here I am using the circle form as limit. My intention with this series is to "find" the form from the ground in a process of refinement using alternating complementary colors. The result is a "not perfect, quite human" circle that resonates with the energy of its discovery. My wish is to provoke a state of rapt stillness...to induce a field of energy exchange between the work and the viewer.

Vibratory color relationships are intrinsic to my exploration of color as energy. Complex complementary color relationships are proxy for the harmonic reconciliation of binary states of being. I seek a unifying of opposites, much in the sense of dualism in the Tao, as yin and yang, as a part of the same unifying life force.

Liminality, a threshold between two conditions or states of being, is an important idea to me as I wrestle with this reconciliation of binaries. This work is also an exploration of Form/Formlessness, Time/Timelessness, Stasis/Flux.

I believe that art's true power lies in its ability to compel one to see in a way never before experienced. Expansion of one's seeing... is an expansion of one's thinking. While my work is not overtly political, it is subversive in its disruption of the expected or "normal".





Linda Price-Sneddon's work is born of the land and its forms, macro and micro. Her process is both scientific and intuitive, often utilizing an underlying set of rules to initiate a work but with final resolution both intuitive and emergent from the physical properties of the material.

A graduate of the School of the Museum of Fine Arts Boston, her paintings and installations have been shown widely in New England and the Pittsburgh area. She's held artist residencies at numerous New England schools and institutions including MASS MoCA's Kidspace and The Fuller Craft Museum and received grants in support of her work from the Greater Pittsburgh Artist Council, Massachusetts Cultural Council, Berkshire Taconic A.R.T. Fund, Target Foundation and Citibank.

Recent projects include the video installation S.H.E. Emergent at the Boston Center for The Arts "Feminist Futurist" exhibition early 2020, stage set design for the Pittsburgh New Music Ensemble's at City Theatre in Pittsburgh in 2018 and an exhibition of works on paper at Chautauqua Institution Strohl Gallery in 2017.



## COMING FROM MULTIPLES LUKE DESMONE

The objects encompass the idea that they are relics of feeling and memory, a general expression of something indicative of the human conscious. Increasingly so, there is a level of nihilism that promotes isolation/consumption within modern living, a cynicism found in vast comfort.

Society, in its many forms of influence, visible through the many personas within, often shows the multiple separations, the need for connection through the self, community, and world by present means. The works are done in reflection if not an honest engagement with varying points of view, a cloudy premonition, much like computer programming, intended action is often accompanied by unforeseen consequences, leaving a necessity to exchange an error.
